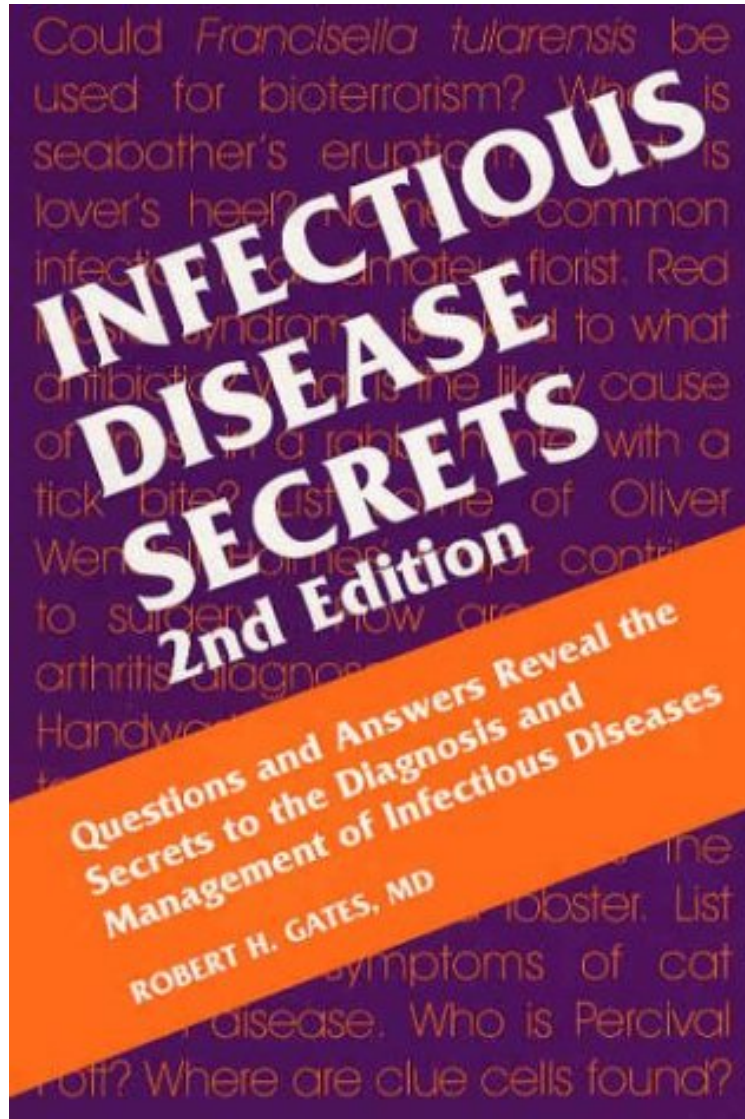

It touches all major subjects in ID, although briefly.Not very useful for clinical medicine.It even has some historical facts about ID that I found very interesting.
